Żurawia 21,05-503 Głosków]. Every day we propose a new menu, prepared on the basis of fresh, high-quality products from France and local suppliers. We also offer catering services for individuals and companies.

Consent

How do we collect information from you?

We collect information from you in the following ways:

- through our website, including forms and cookies (please refer to the relevant cookie notice for further details)
- email, post, and mail correspondence with us
- contact via phone
- our social media channels

- information we receive from external third parties.

Each time we collect personal data from you we will include a link to this privacy policy so you understand how your data might be used. We will also give you the opportunity to opt in or out of certain data used by us.

What information do we collect?

Who has access to your information?

Log Files

BREIZH.pl follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and a part of hosting services' analytics.
